Number week.

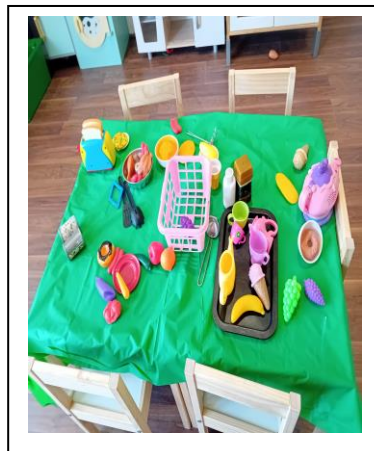
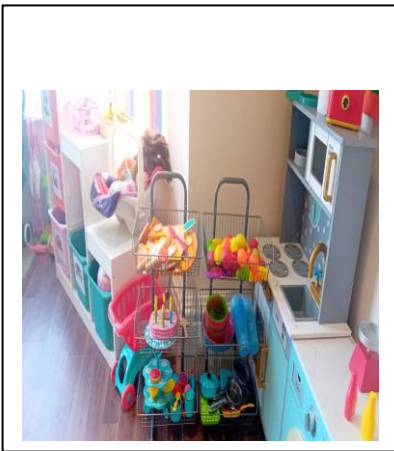
During Islamic session, we will be planning for Jamadiul Akhirah, Rajab and Shabaan.
